Feed Truck Driver JOB DESCRIPTION

1. CDL is not required but preference will be given to applicant who has a CDL.
2. Employee will be required to follow all safety procedures as described in the safety manual and required to report any unsafe conditions to your supervisor immediately.
3. Employee duties regarding feeding cattle:
 - A. Clean moldy or unsatisfactory feed out of bunks **daily** to the satisfaction of the owner and/or foreman of the feedlot.
 - B. Mix feed adequately as instructed on the feed cards.
 - C. Feed cattle in a timely manner.
 - D. Distribute feed evenly in each bunk in the pen. Spilled feed is **your responsibility to CLEAN up!**
 - E. Keep gates closed behind you. "Mix-ups" are easier to prevent than straighten out.
 - F. Look out for cattle in front of you. Injured and crippled cattle are you responsibility.
4. Employee duties regarding maintenance of feeding equipment:
 - A. Employee is totally responsible for the welfare of the feeding equipment.
 - B. Report all major repairs to the shop foreman for repair and maintenance.
 - C. Check oil and grease feed truck daily.
 - D. Have feeding equipment ready at night for the next morning (fuel, oil, grease, etc.)
 - E. Do maintenance of equipment as needed. Wash equipment and keep it clean at all times. Maintenance of **all** pieces of **equipment** is a **must!**
5. Employee is expected to keep bunker clean and all feed stuffs organized property.
6. Employee is expected to help with pen cleaning including driving loaders and manure truck.
7. During harvest time, all employees are expected to help where and whenever needed and directed especially when processing the High Moisture Corn.
8. Employees is expected to do any jobs requested by supervisors, including by not restricted to:
 - A. Cleaning shop
 - B. Washing waters
 - C. Helping with fly control
 - D. Processing cattle
 - E. Doctoring cattle
 - F. Fixing fence and building new fence
 - G. Mowing yard and chopping weeds
 - H. Unloading baled hay/alfalfa
 - I. Cleaning barn
 - J. Painting
 - K. Cutting cedar trees
 - L. Repairing and cleaning any equipment as requested
 - M. Any other job that pertains to smooth operation of this feedlot
